NHS Organ Donor Register

Registering is easy: Online- it just takes a few minutes at organdonation.info, Telephone- 0300 1232323 or Post- fill in a form and return it by free post. Anyone above the age of 14 can sign the register (parents can register children under 14 if the child wishes). It doesn't matter how old you are or how your health is. If the time comes, medical professionals will determine if your organs are healthy and suitable for donation. Doctors will consult this confidential database to see if someone has opted to be a donor.
