Thank you to our parents / carers for completing the Remote Learning survey. We fully understand that Remote Learning was a very difficult time for everyone and taking the time to respond to the survey was very much appreciated.

We had a fantastic response with **38 surveys** completed which is **76% of the families** within the school. I would like to say thank you for your overwhelmingly supportive comments and positive responses.

We have compiled the results and are pleased to present them to you. We are proud to report the following information below: **97%-100%** of parents/carers who replied stated that:

- Seesaw was a useful Remote Learning platform
- Their child was **willing to engage** in Remote Learning
- Learning packs were **suitable and manageable**
- They **are happy with the procedures and routines** the school has put in place to ensure my child's safety and that of the whole Ballylifford PS community.
- Their child/children is /are **well cared for in school**.
- There was good communication between school & home during Lockdown.
- They knew **how to contact** the school or class teacher.
- That their child was happy to return to school.
- That their child feels safe at school.

Parents were not required to leave additional comments but below are some of the positive comments left by parents;

Ballylifford handled remote learning VERY well. They made it very easy to understand for parents and the packs sent home were great. The communication between teacher and parent through seesaw was very reassuring.
