#### DROP OFF 8:30am - 9am.

Children can arrive at school any time between 8:30am and 9am. Children go directly to the school hall and remain there until 8:45am. ## Promoting Positive Behaviour

We pride ourselves in Ballylifford PS as having a high level of Pastoral Care and we always want our children to learn in an environment which is supportive and encouraging. In order for learning to be effective, good discipline and positive behaviour is essential. In school we have a number of Golden Rules, and we have an established system of rewards which promotes positive behaviour. We would like the pupils to maintain their excellent attitude and application to their learning. However, to maintain our excellent standard, it is also necessary to have effective sanctions in place. Sanctions have been discussed and agreed in all classes. Major breaches of discipline may result in loss of playtime at break or lunch time, or a behaviour reflection sheet will be sent home with pupils for parents to sign.
