

<u>CAT4 GL Assessments - P.4 and P.6</u> <u>pupils only</u>

P.4 and P.6 pupils will be completing their CAT 4
Assessments in January — week beginning Monday 22nd
January 2024. Results of these assessments will be shared with Parents/Carers in Term 3.

'CAT4 is an assessment of developed abilities in areas known to make a difference to learning and achievement – namely verbal, non-verbal, quantitative and spatial reasoning – and provides you with an accurate analysis of potential student achievement'.



CCEA Literacy and Numeracy Assessments — P.7 Pupils only

P.7 pupils will complete CCEA Literacy and Numeracy assessments online week beginning 22^{nd} January. This is a pilot project and results will not be shared with parents. As assessments are online, this will provide children with the opportunity to experience computer-based tests as opposed to paper.
