ORDINATION TO PRIESTHOOD

We are asked to remember in our prayers, at this time of great joy, Fr. Carlos Estabon Rojo who was ordained to the Priesthood in St Patrick's Cathedral, Armagh on Sunday 7th May for service in the Archdiocese of Armagh.
