A CANON LAWYER WRITES

All couples who plan to marry in 2023 are reminded that the completion of the necessary Church and State paperwork is a legal requirement and without completion the wedding cannot take place.

The requirements are:

1. Arrange for your pre-marriage course. Details from ACCORD website.
2. Contact Mid Ulster District Council, Magherafelt office, for Notification of Marriage forms
3. Complete pre-Nuptial enquiry Form with respective Parish Priests.

MID-ULSTER DISTRICT COUNCIL

The Marriage Registration Service have written in connection with Notification of Marriage Forms. The Bride and Groom must complete a Notification of Marriage Form.

The officiating Priest must sign both forms.

Signed forms should be returned to the Registrar's Office 8-10 weeks before the wedding date. Telephone 03000 13232 to make an appointment to return forms. Bride, Groom or Family Member may return the forms.
